Dr. Markowsky has been active in Homeland Security since 1999. He has served as the Director of the Homeland Security Lab at the University of Maine, Orono. He currently teaches Cyber Security and also runs the Cyber Security Lab at the University of Maine.

Dr. Markowsky is the Owner and President of Ayers Island, LLC which has been involved in the training of first responders and in providing a training facility for the Maine Civilian Response Team. Ayers Island, LLC was also a subcontractor on an “Operation Safe Commerce” contract.

In addition to his various roles in homeland security at the University of Maine and Ayers Island, LLC, Dr. Markowsky also runs a homeland security seminar and e-mail list which distributes important information for the homeland security sector.

Dr. Markowsky has worked on a wide variety of topics ranging from tracking cyber attacks, to designing distributed sensor systems, to using vibrodiagnostics to analyze cargo containers.

Dr. Markowsky received his B.A., in Mathematics from Columbia University in 1968. He received his M.A., in Mathematics from Harvard University in 1969 and his Ph.D., in Mathematics from Harvard University in 1973.
