Captain Peter Boynton is the Captain of the Port and Sector Commander for Connecticut, Long Island and waters 200 miles offshore, headquartered in New Haven, Connecticut.

He was an early participant in the creation of a partnership between federal and state agencies and private sector businesses that prototyped security enhancements for international containerized cargo.

Captain Boynton has commanded three Coast Guard cutters and served on a total of six cutters spending ten years at sea. He also served as a Director for Global Affairs on the National Security Council at the White House.

He holds a Master's Degree in Public Administration from Harvard's Kennedy School of Government, and a degree in Ocean Engineering from the Coast Guard Academy.

Captain Boynton is licensed in the Merchant Marines. His military awards include the Legion of Merit, Meritorious Service Medal and Presidential Service Badge.
